The first meeting of the U3A Photography Group was held last Thursday afternoon (31st January) with 18 people in attendance.

Group Leader Peter Bland gave a short talk on the history of photography and emphasised how lucky photographers are in this digital age, with the benefits of both quality and quantity of photographs obtainable with modern cameras.

Peter then went on to discuss the format of the group, the initial concept being a monthly field trip. These outings will take place on the third Friday of each month, at a venue to be agreed. On the fourth Thursday afternoon every month there will be a follow-up session in Library. The Library meeting will run through photographs taken on the previous field trip and process some of the images.

After a number of suggestions, it was agreed the first meeting would be at Lost Gardens of Heligan on Friday 15th February. The follow-up meeting in the Library will be on Thursday 28th February.

For the Lost Gardens of Heligan meeting, it was agreed that we would make our own way there but with car sharing where possible, so the group needs to liaise in this matter. Peter said he would be happy to take three or four people in his car.

The entrance price to Heligan gardens is £10 for standard rate, £9 for seniors. The opening hours are 10am to 5pm (last tickets 3:30pm)
